

Safeguarding Reporting Procedures for Middlesex Personnel

About the behavior of an adult /adults in cricket and child / children in cricket

Concerns arise about the behavior of an adult or a particular child
(e.g. suspicions or allegations of poor practice or possible abuse)

The individual alerted to the concern reports the incident / disclosure to the Police, Ambulance Service or Social Services if the child has suffered **significant harm or is in immediate danger**, the individual must then report to the Middlesex Cricket Safeguarding Designated Officer (Katie Berry) and complete the safeguarding incident / concern report form within 24 hours and submit via katie.berry@middlesexccc.com marked urgent.

If significant harm or immediate danger is not applicable, individuals must report directly to SDO - Katie Berry and complete the incident / concern form within 24hrs

The Safeguarding Designated Officer (if appropriate in consultation with Case Management Group and / or Children's Social Care, Police, LADO or ECB) determines the route for further action to be taken (e.g. does the matter appear to be poor practice or possible abuse, and records actions taken and agree).
