

Middlesex Cricket - Specific Consent

Middlesex Cricket is keen to promote positive images of children playing or involved in cricket. In order for Middlesex Cricket to capture, share or publish images where a child can be identified, specific consent from the player and the parent / guardian of the player is required.

Safeguarding recommendations state that the names of players that are under 18 years of age should not be published along-side an image unless specific consent is obtained. Middlesex Cricket recognises that the recognition of achievement and progress for performance cricket is important and therefore wish to give our players & guardians the option of providing the required specific consent, in order for the company to use names and other identifying information along-side images of the player.

The images will be used to:

- 1. promote the player and his/her/them performances on the Middlesex Cricket website, social media channels and printed / online publications.
- 2. To stream and share live and pre-recorded match content via Middlesex Cricket channels and where applicable, channels managed by county cricket partners.
